



Bagged Pennant

- Front fabric 13" X 18"
- Back fabric 14" x 18"
- Sleeve 15" x 7 ½"
- Wadding – 100% cotton or 80/20 – 13" x 18" - optional
- Label
- Template shape downloadable from the website, or make your own.
- Image for front

Method

Sleeve

- Fold in half and sew together with a 1/4" – ½" seam. Put the seam in the middle and press.
- Fold in half and put to one side ready to use.

Back

- Fold in half vertically and press. Using a 6" ruler and a marker (pencil or water soluble) measure a 6" gap in the middle of the fold.
- Using a ½" seam – wide seam makes the sewing of the gap up easier – sew either side of the mark and back stitch. Trim off the folded edge and unfold the fabric. Press seam to one side.
- If you are adding the Clover bondaweb strip, now is the time to iron it to the seam, leaving the paper backing in place. Put to one side.

Assemble the Pennant

- Layer up the Front fabric right side up and Backing right side down. Pin the paper template on the top. Trace around the template. Remove the pins and remove the template. Re pin at the top, middle and bottom. Cut out the template shape from the two layers of fabric.
- Part the two layers gently at the top of the pennant and insert the folded sleeve centrally and pin into place.
- Pin all around the pennant every 2".
- Sew with a ¼ " seam all around the outside edge.
- (If you want to use wadding, layer it at the base of the pile, under the Front and sew around the outside of the pennant and trim the excess wadding away.)
- Pop the pennant through the opening in the back. Take care to pop out the corners.
- Press the edges thoroughly.
- If you have used the Clover strip, remove the paper and press seam closed, otherwise slip stitch the opening closed.
- Add image to front and stitch.
- Add a label by hand or machine to the sleeve.
- Press over the sleeve and top stitch all around the edge of the pennant.
- Slip stitch the sleeve down. Pennant is complete.
